TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Eligibility / Selection Process:

Students are selected for trips on the basis of their exemplary behaviour, community involvement and ability to collaborate effectively, as they will benefit from and contribute positively to the trip. The school reserves the right to refuse students who do not fit this profile, without right of appeal.

Parental Consent:

Parental or guardian consent is required for participation. Consent forms must be submitted to Collège du Léman (CDL) by the deadline indicated.

Important:

Certain trips are exclusive to High School students, making Primary and Middle School students ineligible for these.

What is included in the price:

Transfers from CDL to the airport or train, flight/train costs, transport, hotels, meals, admission to attractions and supervision by experienced CDL staff.

Travel Details

You are responsible for ensuring the accuracy of your travel document details and promptly reporting any errors or discrepancies to CDL.

Baggage

Baggage policies vary by airline. Typically, 1 bag (Max 23 kg) is included.

Important: Changes beyond our control / Unforeseen Changes

Prices and trips depend on the number of students taking part. CDL reserves the right to cancel or modify the trip, with reasonable notice, if the number is insufficient. Compensation does not apply to significant changes beyond our control including, but not limited to, war, threat of war, civil unrest, severe weather conditions, outbreak of infectious diseases or other similar events.

Passport, Visa and Immigration Requirements

You are responsible for meeting the passport, visa, and other immigration requirements relevant to your itinerary. The school-affiliated Travel Agency can assist if requests are made at least 6 weeks before departure.

Insurance

Travel insurance is included in the cost of the trip, but does not cover the risk of cancellation by participants. You have the option of taking out additional private insurance for the duration of the trip.

Travel Advice and Vaccinations

Vaccinations may be required for your intended destinations. The School Health Centre can arrange necessary vaccinations at cost.

Behaviour

Students on CDL trips represent the school and are expected to adhere to the School Behaviour Policy and demonstrate exemplary behaviour. Failure to meet this expectation may lead to repatriation to parents at the parents' own expense.

Registration and Payment

Completing the registration form and sending payment constitutes a firm offer to contract with the school for the trip. This is not an expression of interest but a confirmed booking. Payment must be made by credit card at the time of registration. The booking will not be confirmed until full payment has been received. However, registration and payment do not guarantee a place. Places are allocated according to availability and student eligibility. If CDL is unable to accommodate your child for reasons of capacity or eligibility, the school will promptly refund the full amount paid to the credit card used to register for the trip. Late bookings may incur penalties.

Cancellation fees and Refund Policy

The school advises families to ensure that they take out private travel insurance to help in the unfortunate eventuality where a student cannot take part in a trip, either due to illness or because of changes in circumstances. Cancellations due to change of circumstances incur a 200 CHF administration fee; please notify cancellations in writing to: boardingactivities@cdl.ch
