

HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAMME FOR THE FIRST DAYS 2025-2026

Wednesday, 20th August

Orientation day for High School students and parents **NEW** to CDL

- Welcome tables at Panthers Café and Eiger entrance from 8:00 a.m. Please arrive by 8:30 a.m.
- The first information session for parents and students will start 9:00 a.m. in the Eiger Auditorium.
- Activities to take place during the morning:
 - Tours of the school
 - Introductions and Option Choice checks
 - Collection of Textbooks, Sports Kit, iPads, MacBooks (from Olympus), Locker keys and ID cards (from Mont Blanc)
 - Performing Arts and Student Support Services information session in the Cervin Auditorium, 10.00-11.00 a.m.
 - Team building activities
- Lunch in Concha 12.30-1:30 p.m.
- Mandatory Subject (English, Math, French) Placement Testing (if necessary) in the Cervin building, rooms CR114/115 or CR116/117 from 2:00 p.m. (or Option Choice checks if needed)

Representatives from the Academic Teams, Admissions, Learning Support, Extracurricular, PFA and Charities will be available throughout the day to answer any questions you may have.

To alleviate the problem of parking, we encourage families to park in the "La Bécassière" parking lot (Centre Sportif de Versoix). Parking is free for the first three hours for cars that register at the pay station. Additional hours may be purchased. A shuttle bus will run between the parking lot and the school from 7.45 a.m. to 4.00 p.m.

Monday, 25th August

First day of school for **NEW AND RETURNING** students

The starting time for the different grades has been staggered to allow each year group to be welcomed in turn. Students should come to the Eiger building for meetings scheduled as follows, aiming to arrive at least 10 minutes before the scheduled time:

- Students will be welcomed by the High School academic team and will then meet with their homeroom advisors, who will take them to class for their first advisory session.
- For the first day, students are encouraged to arrive with basic stationery.
- School will finish five minutes early (at 3:45 p.m.) on the first day to allow students taking the bus to find their bus in good time for departure at 4:00 p.m.
- As of the second day, students will start school at 8:20 a.m. and finish at 3:50 p.m. (see daily schedule below).

	<p>For students signed up for the school bus</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Buses will be in place (in front of, and behind, the Olympus building) to take students home after school. Each bus driver will have a list of names of students riding on their bus.
Tuesday, 23rd September	<p>Introduction to high school, informal meeting with teachers and the Welcome Back Barbecue</p> <p>The traditional 'meet the teachers' evening this year will be combined with a short High School introductory presentation and a Welcome Back Barbecue, to be held on Tuesday, 23rd September. This is not a formal parent-teacher event, so no appointment schedule will be needed. More details concerning this event will be sent nearer the time.</p>

Important – For day students:

School Books, Sports Kit, iPads, MacBooks, Locker Keys, Student ID Cards

Please note that we encourage new day students to collect these items on Wednesday, 20th August and returning day students to collect these items from Thursday, 21st August in the Olympus building (see schedule below). Mandatory school textbooks are included in the tuition fee, but sports kit (required for all PE lessons) will be invoiced directly to the students' accounts; iPads will be issued to students new to grades 9/IG1 and 10/IG2. MacBooks will be issued to all new grade 11/IB1 students and to returning grade 11/IB1 students who can exchange their iPad. This will also be the opportunity for students to collect their student ID card and locker key (available in the Mont Blanc Building). Students are strongly encouraged to collect these items ahead of the first day of school to enable them to start the year smoothly.

Note to our boarding families: textbooks and PE kit will be prepared for our boarding students and delivered to the boarding houses. House Parents will assist in the collection of ID cards, iPads, MacBooks and locker keys.
