# SECONDARY ENGLISH

The BSG English Department is inspired by children's writer, Sir Philip Pullman to encourage students to "read like a butterfly and write like a bee". We aim to promote competence, confidence and eloquence in the areas of Reading, Writing and Speaking & Listening in the English Language. The year has seen student success both within and outside of the classroom and highlights of the 2022-23 calendar include: BSG Book Week, House Battle of the Books, the Year 9 Speech Competition and the KS3 Poetry Slam! As ever, we wish to congratulate students for all their efforts with Accelerated Reader, especially those who have read over a million words this year!















# SECONDARY MATHS





The students in the BSG Secondary Maths department have had yet another amazing year. We have completed 5 international competitions resulting in 18 gold certificates, 25 silver certificates, 38 bronze certificates. Pi week involving a record 8 marshmallows in one mouth at one time, Pi being recited by 7 students, each reciting over 100 digits of pi (even in Japanese!), the teachers dressing up as Lord of the Rings bad guys. In IXL, students have completed over 885,000 questions, and in total have spent over 8200 hours working on their IXL. We have awarded 5 Gold Pi badges, 13 Silver Pi badges, and 52 Teal Pi badges! Students in Year 9, 10, and 11 have completed over 45 exams and tests, and Sixth form students have completed over 100 exams and tests in total, and finally, Year 7 and 8 completing over 20 projects in total between them, resulting in over \$50,000 of virtual investment from other students in their final assessment. What a year!! We can't wait to see what happens in BSG 2023-2024! See you there!!
