CURRICULUM

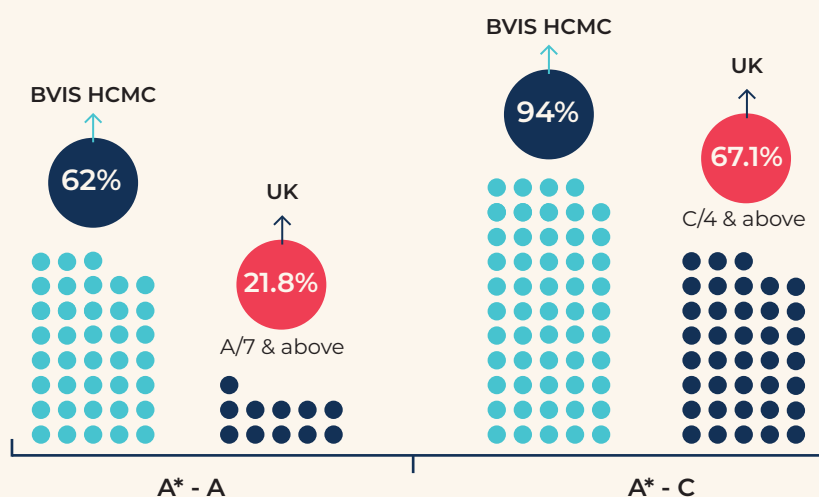
Years 10 and 11

- Cambridge Assessment IGCSE
- Grades awarded on the scale A* to G
- All students take Mathematics, English (1st or 2nd Language), Science (Co-ordinated Science Double Award or Separate Sciences). Some students also take English Literature.
- All students choose three additional subjects from: Drama, Music, Art & Design, Physical Education, Business Studies, Economics, Computer Science, Design & Technology, Geography and History.
- All students also take Vietnamese and Physical Education as non-examination subjects

Year 12 (Grade 11 – Junior Year)	- Cambridge Assessment and Pearson AS Level Examinations - Grades are awarded on the scale A to E - Students usually take three or four subjects chosen from: Mathematics, English Literature, Media Studies, Business Studies, Economics, Art & Design, Design & Technology, Computer Science, Psychology, Biology, Physics, Chemistry, Music and Drama. - All students also take Vietnamese and Physical Education as non-examination subjects, and some do additional courses in academic English.
Year 13 (Grade 12 – Senior Year)	- Cambridge Assessment and Pearson A Level Examinations - Grades are awarded on the scale A* to E - Students usually take three or four subjects which are a continuation of the courses taken at AS Level. - All students also take as non-examination subjects Vietnamese and Physical Education.

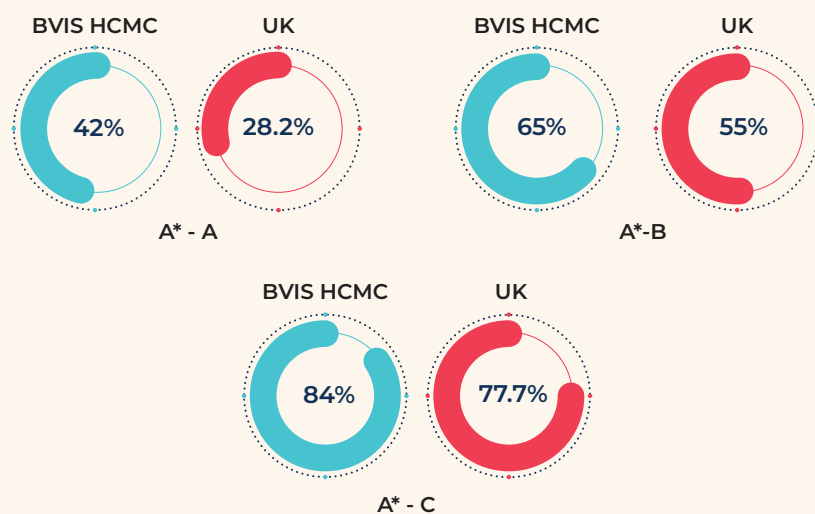

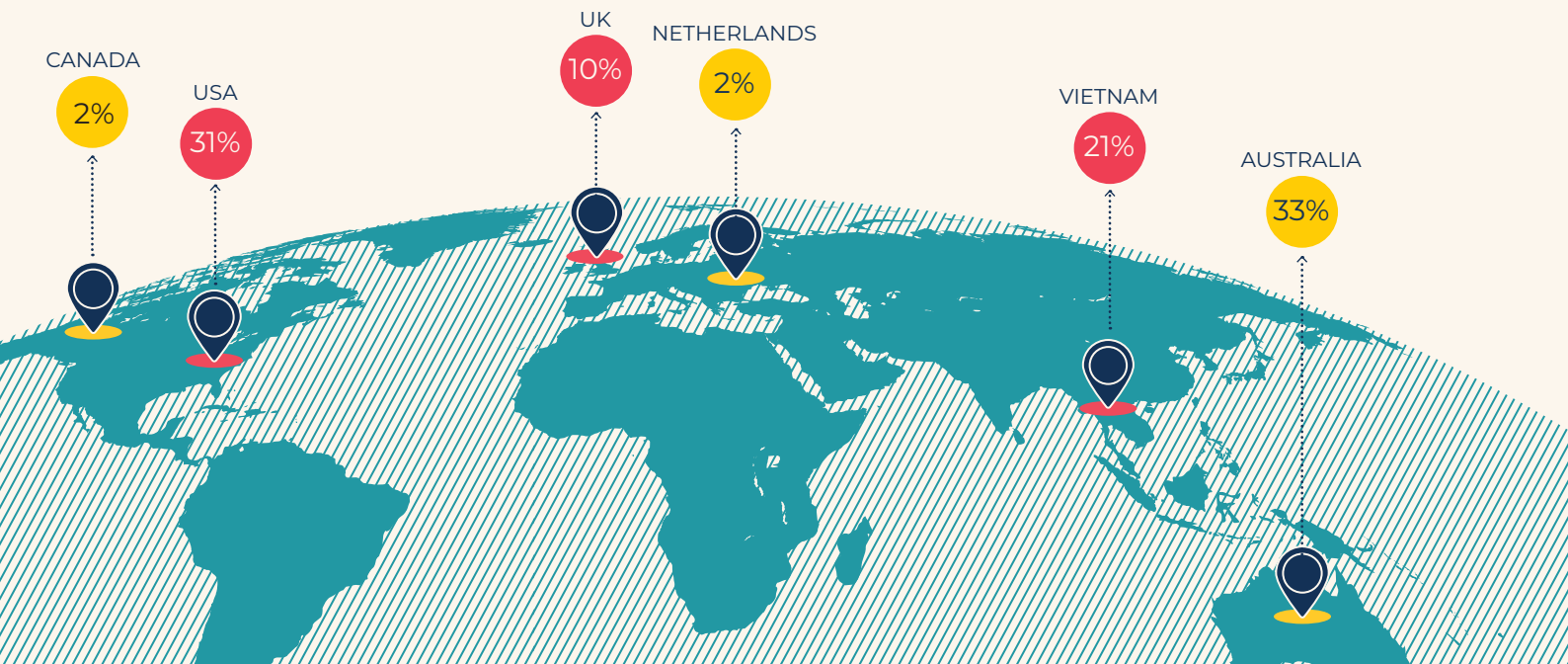
